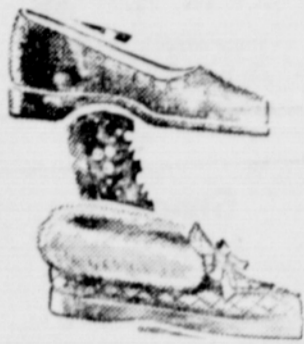
This party will be held on December 17 in the basement of the
