

Oregon Auto Death Rate up

Oregon is in danger of killing more people in traffic accidents this year than in any year since 1952. An estimated 42 traffic deaths in November shoved the state's court for the year-to-date to 387. If December deaths match those of December last year the final toll was 460. November traffic this year

claimed 14 more lives than for the same month last year, the Oregon Traffic Safety Commission reported. Commission secretary, J. R. Banks, said the state has joined a nation-wide campaign, "Back the Attack on Traffic Accidents," which hopes to reduce the accident, injury and death toll over the holiday period and throughout 1957.

Orders Off On Saw Lumber

Douglas fir region sawmill production, orders and shipments for November was reported today by Harris E. Smith, secretary of the West Coast Lumbermen's Association.

The weekly average of West Coast lumber production in November was 172,875,000 b.f. or 93.2% of the 1951-1955 average. Orders averaged 155,251,000 b.f.; shipments 164,715,000 b.f.; weekly averages for October were: Production 179,287,000 b.f.; 96.6% of the 1951-1955 average; orders 173,386,000 b.f.; shipments 168,158,000 b.f.

Eleven months of 1956 cumulative production 8,507,282,000 b.f.; eleven months of 1955, 8,224,953,000 b.f.; eleven months of 1954, 8,011,382,000 b.f. a

Orders for eleven months of 1955 break down as follows: Rail & Truck 5,985,697,000 b.f.; domestic cargo 1,622,251,000 b.f.; export 349,071,000 349,071,000 b.f.; local 344,111,000 b.f.

The industry's unfilled order file stood at 5,866,539,000 b.f. at the end of November, gross stocks at 1,096,601,000 b.f.
