Co-op to Loan On New Wiring

The Coos-Curry Electric Co-operative, Inc. has set up an Adequate Wiring loan plan for the home-owning members. The plan as set up calls for a maximum loan of \$350, with a minimum loan of \$60 and a minimum monthly payment of \$10.

The monthly payments will be included on the power bill and will be for 6, 12, 18 and 24 months. Loans will be for permanent installation only. No white goods will be allowable, but loans will be for outside or inside wiring, wall heaters, etc.

All loans must carry the approval and recommendations for wiring or heating of a licensed electrical contractor, and are to be approved by members of the board of directors.
