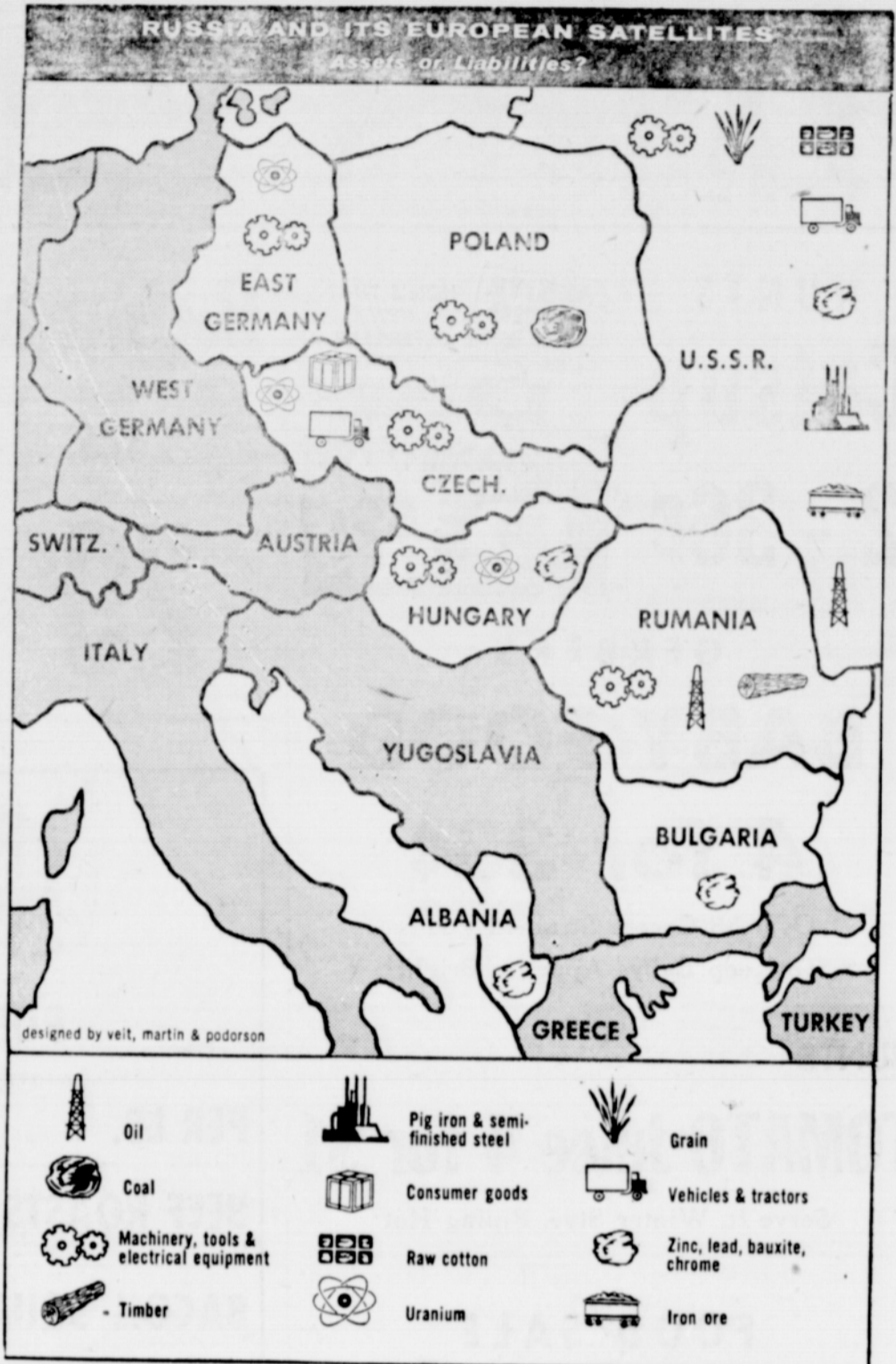

Mrs. A. V. Moore, home economics extension co-ordinator; Walter Wollam, special events chairman.

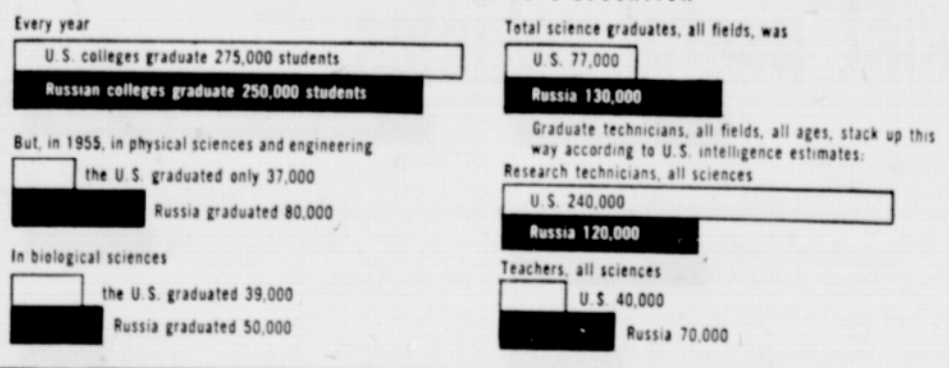
A number of discussion groups have been formed here in the Brookings-Harbor area and it is hoped there will be more. The local groups will begin their discussion meetings the week of January 27th.
