

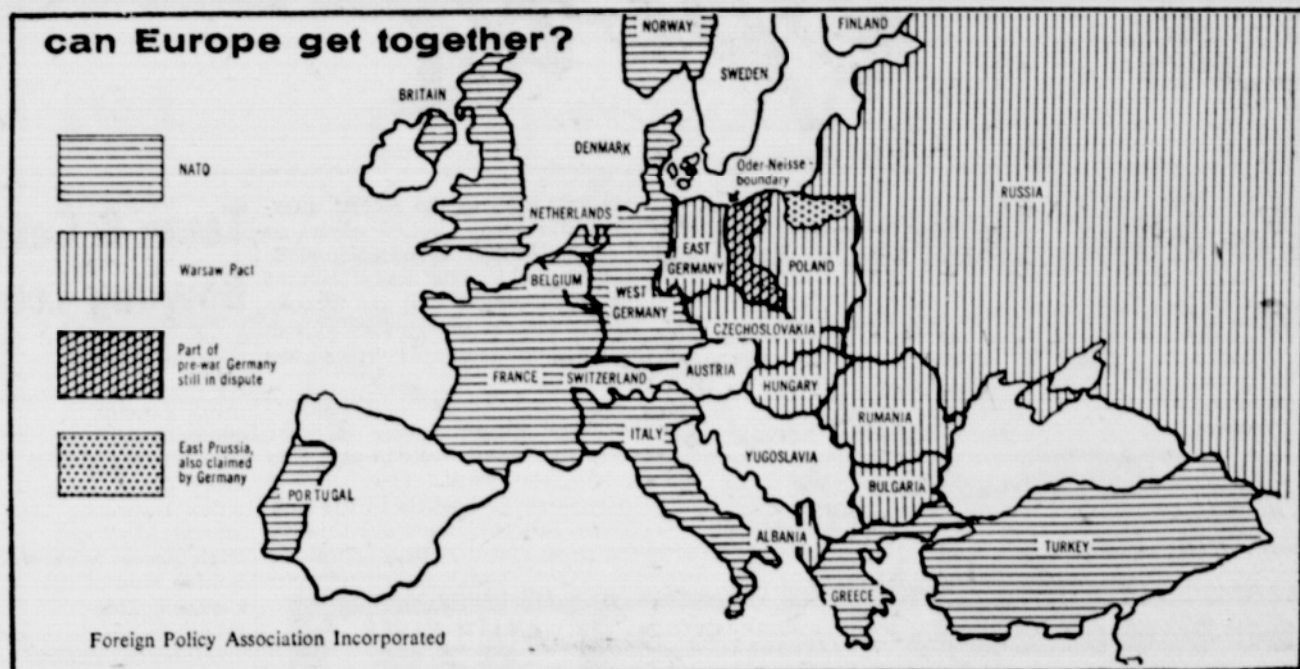

Local School Plans Participation In Great Decisions

Mr. Ralph Fowler, social study teacher of Brookings-Harbor high school, has announced special plans for student and faculty participation in "Great Decision... 1957," a community-wide study of crucial foreign policy issues beginning January 20th.

Mr. Fowler, explained that the Decisions program provides an excellent opportunity for study of foreign affairs and training in good citizenship. Students will discuss the Great Decisions issues in their classrooms, utilizing fact sheets prepared by the Foreign Policy association, a non-partisan, non-government, no-profit, educational organization.

Mr. Fowler, said in an interest- aspect of the Decisions program is that students will examine the same questions utilizing the same materials in the classroom that their parents will be studying in informal home discussion groups. This, he added, was the first such occurrence in Curry county, to his knowledge.

School participation in Great Decisions on a statewide basis is being encouraged by Rex Putnam, Superintendent in a special memorandum sent earlier to all the superintendents and principals in the state. Putnam said teachers and students who had participated in Great Decisions in previous years were enthusiastic about the program.

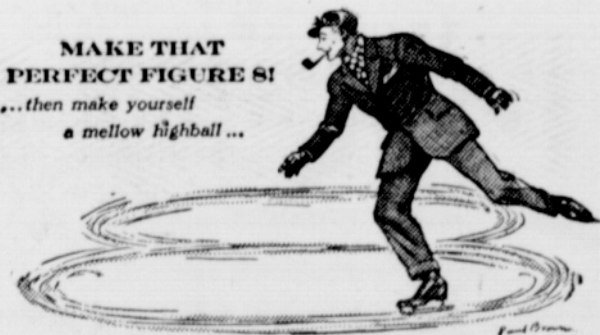
