### March 10 Designated As Lutheran Hour Sunday At Faith Lutheran

Hundreds of congregations of The Lutheran Church-Missouri Synod in the United States and Canada will observe Lutheran Hour Sunday on March 10 with special prayers, sermons, and offerings, it has been announced by Pastor Galambos of Faith Lutheran church.

The first Sunday in Lent has been designated by the Board of Directors of the two million-member church body as a day on which the members may be approached for a special contribution to the work of the global Gospel broadcast.

Currently aired in 53 languages over more than 1200 radio stations located in 63 territories and foreign countries, the Lutheran Hour has as its one purpose, "Bringing Christ to the Nations," and may be heard at 1 p.m. KCRE Sundays or at 5:30 p.m. over KIEM.

The Brookings Bible church announces that Sunday, March 10, they will have a Sunday School bus in operation. The service is free to all who wish to use this convenience whether young or old.

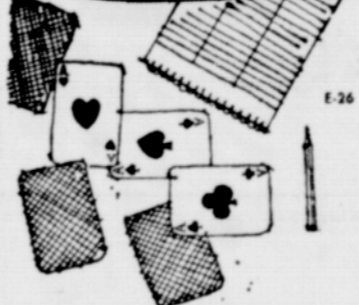
A tentative schedule has been arranged beginning on Park View Drive at 8:20 a.m. and arriving at the church in time for Sunday school at 9:45 a.m. The route will be: Down Park View Drive to Hiway; up Ranson, across Second, down Easy to Hiway; down Arnold Lane and back to Hiway. Coming into town the bus will go down Cottage and Hemlock streets. A trip out to Harbor will include turning right at the 101 cafe onto Benham Lane and following the loop back to the Hiway. Also service to the Harbor Tender Court is being planned. Then around 9:20 the bus will follow Spruce St. through the Beresa Tract and on to the church by way of De Norte. The service is free and the driver will be Mr. G. A. Lindsey.

Also on March 10 the Brookings Bible church will institute its first Junior church service at 11:00. Mrs. Marion Comfort will be in charge and all children from 4-8 years will enjoy their own church service. At the same time Mrs. Claude Moore will supervise the nursery program for children under 4 yrs.
