Graduating seniors of Gold Beach and Brookings high schools who plan to follow teaching careers are eligible to apply for one of the \$500 scholarships offered by Consolidated Freightways, Inc., the company announced today.

Brookings is one of 56 communities across the country whose high school seniors are eligible for the award.

The company is offering a total of 18 scholarships to students living in communities which have C-F terminals and population of less than 50,000.

Students will submit their applications to a local committee for preliminary consideration. The committee, composed of educators and civic leaders, will select a nominee and forward its recommendation to a final judging committee.

Winners of the "Highway to Learning" scholarships will be chosen on the basis of their scholastic records, extra-curricular ac-

activities, placement in college entrance examinations and their promise as future pre-college teachers.

The competition here is being organized by Peter Basich, manager of the local C-F terminal. Scholarships were first awarded by C-F in 1952, after the company established a scholarship fund in lieu of giving Christmas remembrances to its customers. Prior to this year, applications were considered from high school seniors in any of the states served by Consolidated, regardless of the applicants' career aims.

"In recognition of the alarming shortage of pre-college teachers particularly in the small community, we have decided to revise our scholarship rules, J. L. S. Snead Jr., C-F President said.

"It is no exaggeration to say that the security and well-being of our country depends in large measure upon its youth and their ability to meet the future intelligently. The good teacher is an essential national resource."

The Brookings-Harbor Chamber of Commerce board of directors discussed the possibility of hiring a full time paid secretary-manager of the Chamber of Commerce here at their regular meeting last week.

It was generally agreed that a man be hired, although the board didn't take any official action, pending investigation of a budget, and the means of raising funds to pay for the man. One estimate of cost for a paid secretary-manager would be around \$6,000 a year.

The directors also spent an hour and a half discussing the highway 101 bond issue, now up before legislative committees. They formulated a plan of action, and are in the process of preparing a brief to present to the State Senate on the matter.
