

Army Plans Europe Tour

Here's your chance to see Europe. Word has been received that the 546th Field Artillery Battalion, 155 millimeter lowitzer, will leave its home station at Ft. Lewis, Wash., for assignment to the European theater.

Effective immediately, personnel who qualify for enlistment in the U. S. Army, can, upon request, be assigned to this unit. Enlistments must be completed prior to 25 March 1957.

Those accepted will complete basic training at Ft. Ord, Calif., after which they will be assigned to the 546th Field Artillery Battalion at Ft. Lewis, Wash. This unit will depart the United States on or about 15 October 1957.

Saving Bonds Hits Drop Here

Sales of E and H Savings Bonds in February were substantially down from what they were a year ago. Figures for the year to date compare fairly well with 1956.

Curry County Savings Bond Committee chairman said that February sales of United States Treasury E and H Savings Bonds in the state were \$2,655,816 against a total of \$4,765,309 in 1956.

Curry County sales for the month of February were \$22,383 compared to \$29,577 for February of last year.

Suspend Licenses On 624 Drivers

Licenses of 624 Oregon drivers were suspended during February, 256 of them after conviction of driving while intoxicated.

Drunk driving far outnumbered all other reasons for suspension in the monthly listing by the Department of Motor Vehicles. Next closest contender was "driving record" which accounted for 76 suspensions by officials.

These suspensions came to drivers known as accident or violation repeaters and are given interviews fail to result in an improved record.

Other reasons for suspensions included: reckless driving, 40; violation of basic rule, 41; hit and run, 4; failure to stop, 6; failure to yield right of way, 4; driving while suspended, 67; failure to report an accident, 43; failure to pass tests, 11; failure to appear, 9; failure to complete tests, 1; fatal accident involvement, 3; medical reports, 2; and miscellaneous, 53.

License suspensions are given either on court recommendation, discretionary action of licensing officials or mandatory provision of the Law.

SICK LEAVE FOR COUNTY EMPLOYEES

WHEREAS, Curry County, Oregon employees are not presently receiving payment for days on which they are unable to work by reason of illness; and
WHEREAS, Section 203.120 S 15 O. R. S. empowers this Court sick leave with pay to County to provide for the granting of employees; and
WHEREAS, it is the desire of this Court to relieve the full time employees of Curry County from part of the hardships accompanying the misfortune of illness;
NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that all regular full time, non-elective, employees of Curry County, Oregon be allowed one day of sick leave with full pay for each full calendar month of regular employment.

Days of sick leave unused may accumulate for later use, but in event shall the total accumulated days of sick leave exceed 24 days.

Sick leave time shall be available only for full days of absence from regular employment because of actual illness requiring such absence.

NEITHER CURRENT OR ACCUMULATED SICK LEAVE SHALL BE USED FOR VACATION PURPOSES OR FOR ANY PURPOSE OTHER THAN ABSENCE OCCASIONED BY ACTUAL ILLNESS REQUIRING THE ATTENTION OF A PHYSICIAN, WHOSE CERTIFICATE AS TO THE NATURE AND DURATION OF SUCH ILLNESS SHALL BE REQUIRED TO BE PRESENTED TO THE COUNTY COURT BEFORE SUCH PAYMENT OF SICK LEAVE BENEFITS UNDER THIS ORDER SHALL BE MADE.

Sick leave benefits herein provided shall be for those employees of Curry County who are regular, full time, employees of Curry County regularly and continuously employed not less than Regular hours monthly.
