ORDER WHEREAS Clarence H. Brooks, Langlois, Oregon, has honorably and efficiently served his 3 year appointment as member of the Curry County Fair Board, and

WHEREAS, it now becomes necessary to appoint a successor to fill the vacancf created by the expiration of the appointed term of the said Clarence H. Brooks, now

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that Clarence H. Brooks, Langlois, Oregon, be appointed to succeed himself, as a member of the Curry County Fair Board to serve for 3 years, to-wit to March 20, 1960. Said appointment to be effective on his filing a bond as required by law.

IN THE MATTER OF DOGS

ORDER WHEREAS, due to the laxity of dog owners in Curry County, and

WHEREAS, the license fees for the current year have not been paid and it is necessary to employ an officer for the enforcement of provisions as provided in chapter 609.030 O. R. S., and

WHEREAS, it is believed that said Enforcement Officer can expedite the collection of said dog license in the County, now

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that John D. Johnson, Port Orford, Oregon be appointed as Dog License Enforcement Officer to collect said license fees to be, as provided in chapter 609.100 O. R. S., to-wit: For each male dog or spayed bitch \$1.00 or each bitch \$1.50 which is basically and enforceable to the 1st of March of any year. After this date a penalty may be imposed in double the amount as afore mentioned, to-wit: For each male dog or spayed bitch \$2.00, for each bitch \$3.00. These last mentioned fees are now subject to collection for the remaining calendar year;

BE IT FURTHER ORDERED, that the said John D. Johnson, shall post a bond of \$2,000.00, cost of said bond to be paid from the dog fund. This appointment shall become effective on filing of the bond with the Curry County Court. All fees collected shall be turned in to the County Clerk on or before the 10th of the month following collection. The Clerk shall remit to said Enforcement Officer 50% of the fees collected as his compensation for his services.
