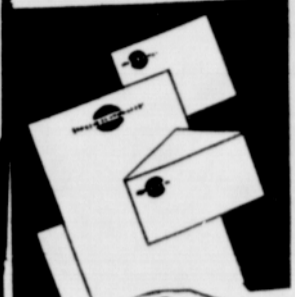

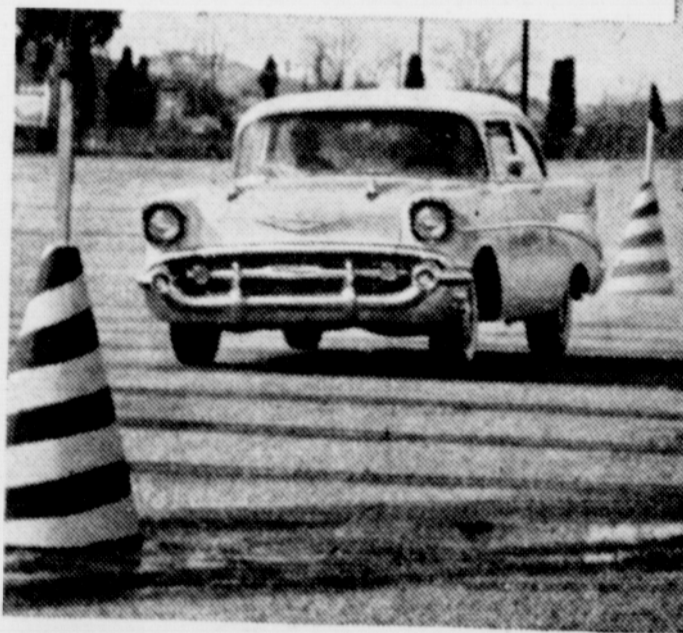
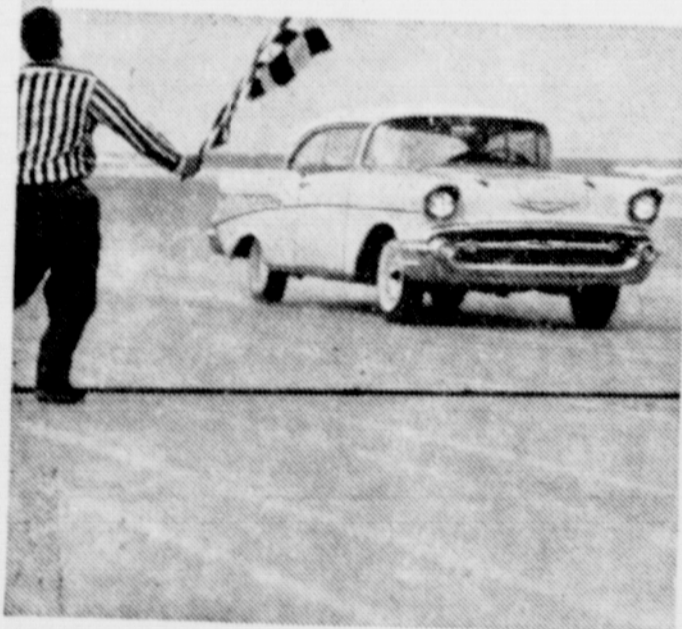

**BANK CONDITION HERE IS REPORTED**

The United States National Bank of Portland showed deposits totaling \$733,818,188 as of March 14, 1957, according to figures just released.

The Brookings branch reported deposits of \$3,880,889.61 announced K. J. Kirk, manager.

Total resources for the statewide system stood at \$82,538,496. Loans and discounts are up almost 10 million dollars since the spring call a year ago and now total \$330,154,438.

Loans and discounts for the Brookings branch now stand at \$3,095,114, Kirk reported.

Continuing its statewide building program, U. S. National completed new branch buildings at Albany and Newberg during the first two months of this year. A major remodeling project is now in progress at the Coos Bay branch.
