

TRAGEDY STRIKES AGAIN AT NICHOLS

Just one day after a fire had practically destroyed the home of Mrs. Lola Nichols, of Brookings, her six year old daughter died at the Curry County Hospital.

The little girl, Linda died last Wednesday after an emergency chest operation to restore her stopped heart failed.

The child had been in frail health since her birth, her mother reported, and here reported, and her heart was not beating when she was born but she was revived in an oxygen tent at that time, however.

The little girl was undergoing a tonsillectomy in the early morning. After returning to her room her heart stopped beating, and she was rushed back to the operating room for the emergency operation.

The stopped heart was massaged for eight minutes and it resumed its beating. She was returned to her room but died at 4:45 p. m. several hours later.

Pesides her mother, she was survived by a brother, James 5, and a sister, Shirley, 3. Her father, Jim, was someplace in California. He was a former operator of the Nichols Woodyard here.

Last year the Nichols family won the new Plymouth awarded by the North Brookings Boosters.

Last Tuesday, little Jimmie was playing with matches, and set fire to his house, doing damages estimated at \$1,500.

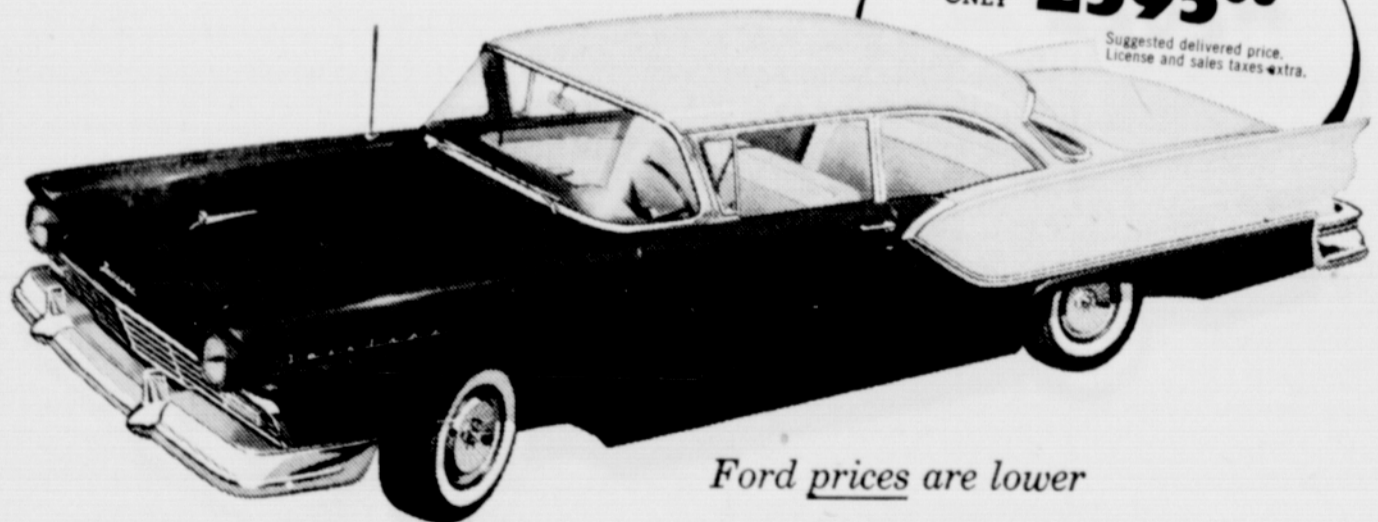
