ELKS PRESENT CONCERT MONDAY

The Brookings Elks Lodge #1934 is presenting a piano and organ concert to aid the program for visually handicapped children sponsored by the Oregon State Elks Association, at the University of Oregon Medical school.

Mary Hysom, Alaska's foremost concert pianist with Clarence Dial at the Organ will provide the talent for the show, which will be held Monday evening May 6, at 8:15 p. m. in the high school auditorium.

Tickets may be purchased at Endert's Drug store and Garrisons Music Store in Crescent City, as well as many places locally. Adults tickets are 1.50 and children are .75¢.

The major phase of the program is medical and surgical services to children from low income families. From the start of the program in 1949 5,200 children received care in the clinic, which totaled over 30,000 visits.

Nearly 600 children had major surgery of the eye requiring anesthesia. 244 operations were performed for Strabismus. Research plays an important part in this program as well as rehabilitating the visually handicapped children.

The highlight of the evening will be the well known and beautiful Schumann concerto in "A" minor, featuring the two instruments in place of the usual orchestral accompaniment; an unusual but extremely effective combination. Appearing as soprano soloist with Mrs. Hysom will be her daughter, Louise Ruder.
