GEORGE FUNK RETURNS FROM HAWAII

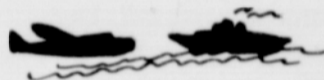
Mr. and Mrs. George Funk returned Wednesday morning from a 15 day visit to Hawaii. The Funks visited relatives there besides looking the islands over.

Bill Thompson was in Brookings last weekend, and attended a farewell party held for him at the Bob Swanson home.



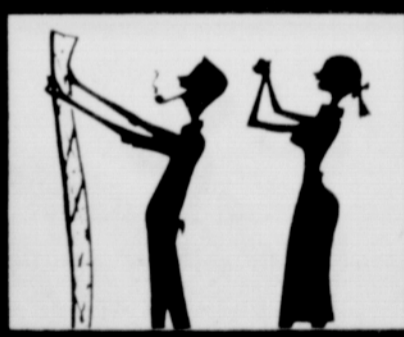
