

EDEN RIDGE GETS ANOTHER CHECK

Pacific Power and Light Co. engineers spent all day Saturday touring the company's proposed Eden Ridge hydro and steam power project on the Coquille river's south fork, just north of Curry County.

The tour was to familiarize them with the \$60 to \$70 million project which is expected to fire a business and industrial boom in Southwestern Ore.

The consensus of opinion in the survey was that the project definitely will be built, and in the near future. The combination steam and water power plant will make use of extensive unused coal beds at the plant site.

RIVER QUEEN PLAN ANNOUNCED.

That was the view of one of the contractors who was down to look over the site, and to check specifications.

Several contractors have been reported in the area, including one from Coos Bay, another from Medford, and a third from Portland.

The contractors were planning on bidding on the job. The bids were called by the U.S. Army Engineers, and the details of the bidding should be known locally by Friday. The proposed jetties at the mouth of the Chetco will require a government expenditure of about \$400,000.

One of the contractors indicated that the jetty would be completed in less than 80 days from the time of the actual work start.

However, most of the contractors were concerned about rock, and the availability of good rock for use in the construction. The possibility of taking rock out of nearby islands was looked into.

The Cliff House is now a member of the Diner's Club, according to Bill Preisinger, who operates the popular Brookings night spot.

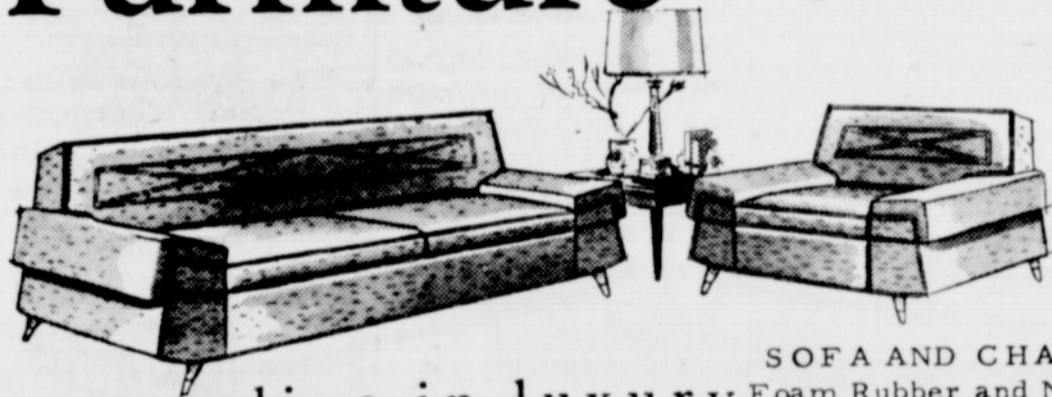
Preisinger said that the national organization is catching on rapidly all over the country. He invites club members among the local business and professional people to participate at the Cliff House.

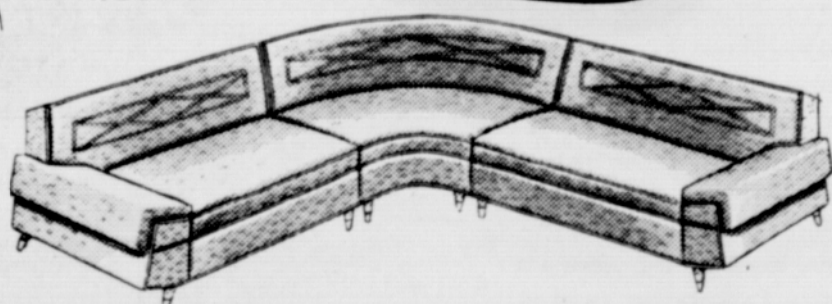

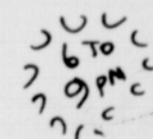
