BULLETIN ON PESTS TO HELP FARMERS

"Vegetable Garden Insect Pests" is the title of an Extension Bulletin that can help farmers and gardeners in their never-ending fight against insects, according to Lou Oester, County Extension Agent.

This bulletin illustrates all of the common garden insect pests and gives recommendations for their control. The life habits and the damage caused by the insect is also discussed.

Most gardeners are familiar with the different kinds of aphids that attack vegetables and flowers. Malathion used as a fifty percent emulsifiable concentrate or as a five percent dust is recommended for this pest. Nicotine sulfate has been an old standby for aphid control but it is difficult to get high enough temperatures along the coast to make this material fully effective.

This bulletin is available at the county extension office in Gold Beach and at the branch offices in Brookings and Langlois.

NOTICE OF SCHOOL Election in the rural school district of Curry County, Oregon upon question of increasing tax levy over amount limited by Section 11, Article XI, State Constitution.

Notice is hereby given that an election will be held Monday, May 20, 1957, by the rural School District of Curry County, State of Oregon, in all component school districts of said Rural School District.

The election will begin at 2-8 p.m. and will be held in the schoolhouse in each of said component districts. The purpose of the election is to submit to the legal voters of the rural school district the question of increasing the tax levy for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1957; over the amount limited by Section 11, Article XI of the Constitution.

The reasons for increasing such levy are; The necessary expense of operating the school exceeds the tax base of the Rural School District, which is the sum of all the tax bases of all the school districts in the County, except school districts #2CJ and 17C.

The amount of tax in excess of the six percent limitation proposed to be levied by the rural school district of Curry County, Oregon, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1957, is \$215,315.26.


