A more somber observance will be the Fleet of Flowers Memorial Day service at Depoe Bay May 30th. Many fishing boats and similar craft from many parts of the coast will participate in services dedicated to those who have lost their lives at sea.

are cast on the Pacific ocean waters after the boats travel a mile from shore in the Memorial Day ceremony.
