IMPORTANT SCOUT MEETING BILLED

An important Scout Building meeting is planned for Friday, May 10th, according to Mike Page, local Scouting enthusiast. The meeting will be held beginning at 8:00 P. M., and all those interested in scouting are urged to attend.

REPORT ON SCOUT BUILDING

It seems that the building is getting finished slowly. Mr. Jochens is busy putting the plumbing in, and Mr. Bankus is expected to have the water and meter installed by that time. Mr. Ben

Jones has been putting the wiring in, all in conduit pipe, which will meet all building codes. Mr. Gene Cunningham of Brookings Plywood has finished installing and putting stops on all of the windows. Carter and Rush Wood Yard has donated two loads of wood for the fire place. Mr. Frank Thompson has finished digging the ditch for the sewer line and water line, and Mr. Jochens has the pipes all in the ditch. Mr. Fred Flynn, County Commissioner, has promised to put 5 loads of gravel in front of the building for park-

ing. The City Manager, Rev. Spencer, said that the city grader would level it off. The Scouts of Troop 32 are getting ready to go on a flag selling campaign, all funds to go to the building. The flagpole will be up shortly. Mr. Hannan of the Brookings Plywood Corp. is making 2 irons to hold it up with.

Now, the financial condition of the building is in bad shape, as usual. There is about \$1,200 owing on the building, besides what is needed to finish up the inside and waterproof the outside. There is a meeting

Friday, May 10th at 8:00 PM at the Scout Building. Anyone who wishes to express any criticism, or has any suggestions should attend this meeting.

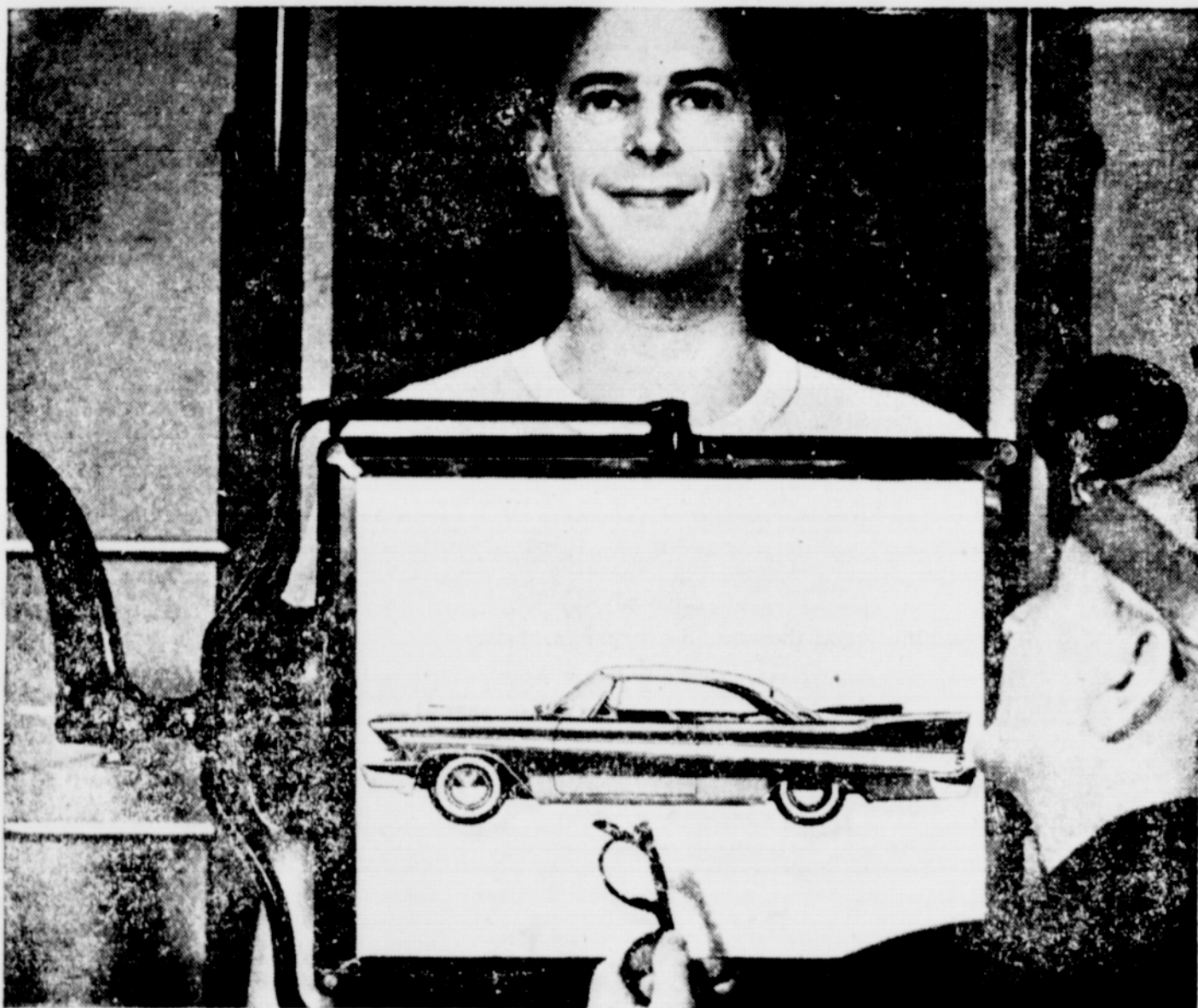
We think that this building is a credit to the community. It is now being used by 11 different groups of children per week, besides the different committee meetings from time to time on the Scouting program.

SCHOOL FUND NEAR

Brookings could get an additional \$12,000 this coming year from the Basic School Support if the bill currently in the State legislature passes as it is in its present form. The school currently receives \$80 a year per child. The basic support would be increased to \$90 per child, if the bill passes. Supt. D. D. Williams estimates that additional revenues would be about \$12,000 per year here.

Williams also was enthused about the \$5,000,000 in the hopper for school construction for distressed districts. He said that if the bill passes, Brookings is in a good spot to get some state funds for construction as we are among the most distressed districts in the state.
