# HIGHWAY DEPT. TO COUNT

Traffic counting operations will be carried on by the State Highway Department in Brookings beginning June 17, it has been announced by W. C. Williams, State Highway Engineer.

The numerous small black tubes which will be seen on the streets are part of the automatic equipment used in making the count.

The traffic count provides a basis for determining the vehicle miles handled by each city street. This information is used by the State Highway Department in its planning program and is also available for the use of municipal officials.

Counting operations in Brookings will be carried out by John Barlow, District Traffic Survey Supervisor from Roseburg.
