The firm is incorporated in Salem, and is attempting to be a "motor service club for trucks."

The new group, Deets said will provide a trucker with legislation, ambulance service, legal advice, bail money, public relations, and safety, and discount service.

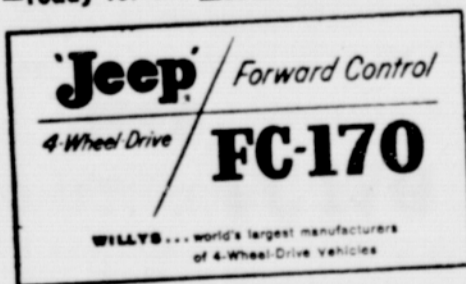
