Frank Chapin was visiting in Brookings this week.

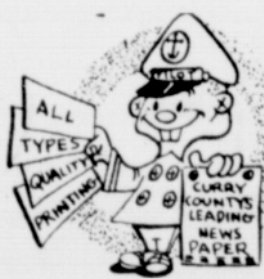

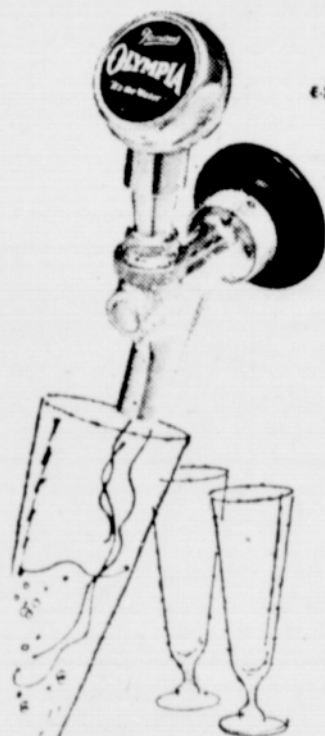
LEROY BECKER OF HARBOR DIES JULY 10

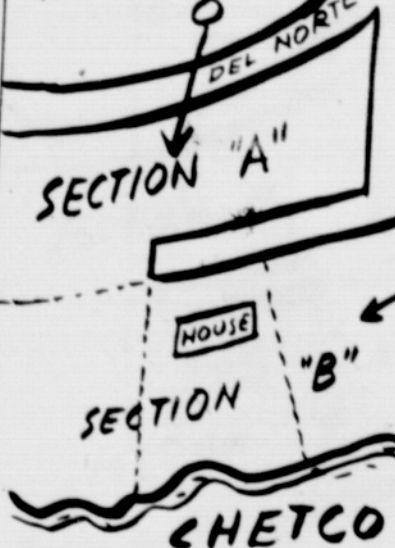
