NICKEL INDUSTRY DISCUSSED

Reports were made on the plans of the Nickel Corporation of America to build a plant in the Illinois river valley north of Cave Junction to produce some 30,000, -

30,000,000 pounds of nickel annually from nearby ore. The plant would employ about 750 workers, the firm estimates.

However, after the firm had acquired mineral lease rights in the area the office of defense mobilization has momentarily stymied further plans because they informed the company that it has already bought or committed itself to buy sufficient nickel for stockpile, so it isn't interested.

The firm must have a five year contract for the purchase of nickel, or it wouldn't risk a \$20,000,000 or \$30,000,000 investment in the area.
