"United States of America, Libellant, vs. 195 Cases, more or less, "SS & G CHOPPED MUSHROOMS", 27 Cases, more or less, "KNAUST'S SLICED MUSHROOMS"; and 34 Cases, more or less, "KNAUST'S PIECES AND STEMS MUSHROOMS" Respondent", brought under the provisions of Section 334, Title 21, U.S.C., wherein it is sought to have the above entitled property condemned and forfeited for the following reasons: That on or about February 20, 1957, November 6, 1956, and December 22, 1955, Pacific Coast Merchandise Co., did sail, ship, and consign from Hudson, New York, to Portland, Oregon in interstate commerce, the said above-described food product; that the same was misbranded when introduced into and while in interstate commerce, within the meaning of the Federal Food, Drug and Cosmetic Act, 21 U.S.C. 343 (h) (2) in that it purports to be and is represented as canned mushrooms, a food for which a standard of fill of container has been prescribed by regulations promulgated pursuant to 21 U.S.C. 341, and it falls below such standard as provided in Paragraph 51.503 (a), and the labels on said mushrooms fail to bear, in such manner and form as Paragraph 51.503 (e) specifies, a statement that they fall below such standard. That all persons claiming any right, title or interest in and to the said above-described property are hereby notified to appear on or before the 12th day of August, 1957, in the Federal Court in Portland, Oregon, to show cause, if any there be, why the same should not be decreed against and forfeited to the United States as misbranded.

MONTHLY LUMBER FACTS

Douglas fir region sawmill production, orders and shipments for June were reported today by Harris E. Smith, secretary of the West Coast Lumbermen's Association.

The weekly average of West Coast lumber production in June was 183,747,000 b.f. or 100.6% of the 1952-1956 average. Orders averaged 181,882,000 b.f.; shipments 197,095,000 b.f.; weekly averages for May were: Production 181,011,000 b.f.; 99.1% of the 1952-1956 average; orders 192,381,000 b.f.; shipments 181,534,000 b.f.

Six months of 1957 cumulative production 4,588,008,000 b.f.; six months of 1956, 4,705,622,000 b.f.; six months of 1955, 5,095,470,000 b.f.

Orders for six months of 1957 breaks down as follows; Rail and Truck 3,119,630,000 b.f.; domestic cargo 991,417,000 b.f.; export 193,519,000 b.f.; local 169,765,000 b.f.

The industry's unfilled order file stood at 617,704,000 b.f. at the end of June, gross stocks at 1,171,883,000 b.f.

EARNINGS DISTRIBUTED

A record distribution of \$415,406.05 in earnings from the irreducible school fund to the public schools of Oregon was authorized Tuesday by the State Land Board.

Governor Robert D. Holmes, Chairman of the Board, said the figure which represents just over 87 cents for each of the State's 475,293 school children, was the highest rate in 35 years.

Earnings are from nearly \$4,000,000 in irreducible funds collected by the Land Board from the sales of school grant lands, timber from the lands and royalties from sand and gravel removed from the beds of Oregon's

navigable streams, Governor Holmes explained. The funds are invested in mortgage loans and bonds approved by the State Bond Commission.
