MONUMENT SITE GETS STUDY

Chetco District Ranger, W.E. Ragland reported that he led a group in to inspect the site where a Navy plane had crashed during the war, and where the bodies of the fliers are still buried.

The site is in extremely rough country, far off any trail, and the government has been trying for some time to build a monument in that location.

COAST GUARD MAY PUT BOAT AT CRESCENT CITY

The Coast Guard may put in an 83 foot patrol boat in the Crescent City harbor, providing that facilities are made available for the craft.

Facilities include ample docking space, electrical power, and water connections capable of delivering 1,000 gallons of fresh water a day for use by the vessel, plus a suitable rain tight building for use by Coast Guard personnel.

The boat would require about 10 officers and crewmen to man.
