

GRAND JURY TO CONVENE WED.

The Curry County Grand Jury will convene Wednesday, Sept. 4th., 1957, at 10 o'clock A.M. in the Court House in Gold Beach. The Grand Jury assembles by order of Dal M. King, Circuit Judge.

The grand jury membership is, George Mateer, foreman, Irene Newell, Ariel Mac Donak, J. Arlie McLeod, James B. Costa, John G. Lyle and Walter E. Davids.

In discussing the powers and duties of the Grand Jury, Ed. F. Ackley, District Attorney said, "The grand jury inquires into all crimes committed or triable in Curry County. It is also given the power to inquire into the condition and management of every public prison in the county and of the offices pertaining to courts of justice. The grand

jury submits indictments to the circuit court.

It also may find "not a true bill", which means that some complaint against a person has been investigated but where in the grand jury will not vote an indictment, usually because of lack of evidence pointing to the commission of the crime charged.

It is customary to call the Grand Jury into session immediately preceding the following term of Circuit Court. The Sept. 1957 term of Circuit Court for Curry County will convene at 10 o'clock A.M., Monday Sept. 9, 1957 at the county courthouse in Gold Beach.
