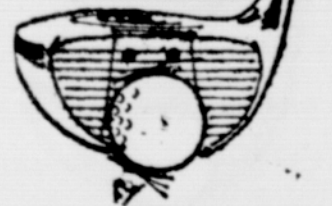
Dr. Brown will be the examining physician. Physical examinations will be given. Dorothea Miller, public health nurse, will assist.

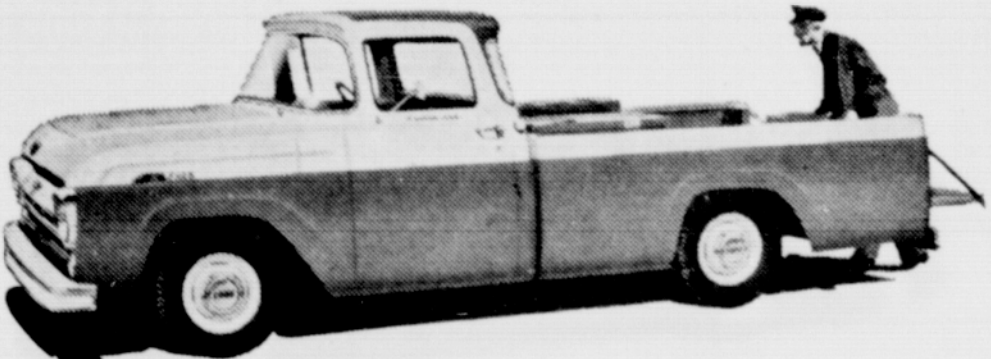
