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LETTER WRITING WEEK OCT. 6 TO 12

International Letter Writing Week will be celebrated in Brookings during the week of October 6-12, Postmaster Gilman Lindsey announced today.

Commenting on the establishment of International Letter Writing Week, Mr. Lindsey pointed out that each year since 1938 the Post Office Department has joined in the observance of National Letter Writing Week--an annual event celebrated to emphasize the meaning and value of letter writing as a symbol of American Freedom.

"As a result of its success," Postmaster Lindsey stated "National Letter Writing Week will be conducted on an international basis this year for the first time. International Letter Writing Week is

based on the idea that written communication between people in all the countries of the world will contribute towards the building of a lasting peace.

"I am sure that we are all aware that a personal letter, is, next to an actual visit, the most intimate means each of us has to communicate with our fellow human beings. Letters between peoples of different nations are a sure method of establishing friendly relationships and understandings. The problems of freedom loving peoples will be more quickly solved if they are better understood.

Mr. and Mrs. Bill Gosset and family have moved to Warden, Ore. near Klamath Falls.

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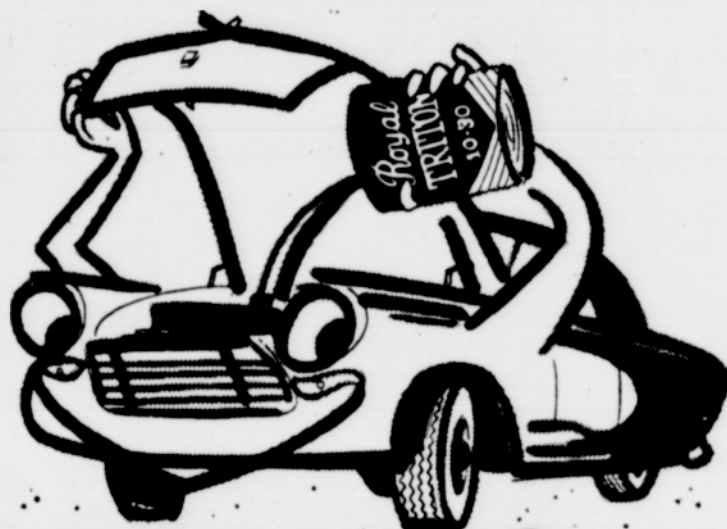
