Mrs. Merl Blackall has moved to Portland where she will reside. Frank Newland hauled her goods there by truck Sunday.

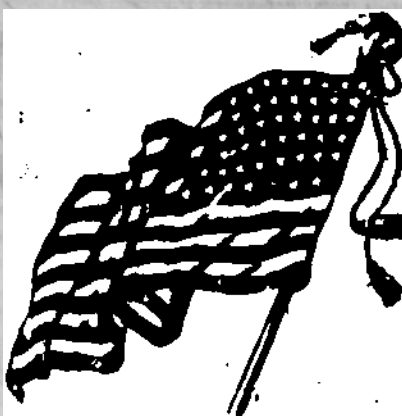
The Willamina schools will open their doors for the seasons' term next Monday. The high school will again be in charge of Prof. Nelson.
