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KEEP OUT "RED" LUMBER—PROTECT OUR INDUSTRY

Russian convict-made lumber is said to be flooding the United States in unfair competition with our lumbering industry. The temporary ban on lumber imports should be made permanent, or effective until such a time as our mills are unable to supply the home markets. Bear this in mind when candidates for Congress come around soliciting your vote.

It is said that even if imports of Russian lumber to America were prohibited, still the Soviet convict-made product would pour into other countries and compete with American lumber. Be that as it may, we can't expect to dictate to other countries about their imports.

However, any man who has traveled over the U. S. and observed the lumbering industry, will not be alarmed about us not being able to unload a great part of our lumber in foreign lands. If we keep unfair competition out, before many years our mills will find it difficult to supply the domestic demand. The Pacific Northwest now commands the greatest lumbering industry in the nation, and, in our opinion, this corner of the country will soon be kept busy supplying lumber for the whole.

The Times says, without an if or an and, keep out foreign products of any kind that compete with American industry and prostrate the nation. It is said that unemployment is exactly the soil the Soviet Reds need in which to sow the seeds of Bolshevism, with the hope of reaping revolution.

Our answer should be a "revolution of ballots" this fall, calculated to build a wall around our struggling lumbering industry.
