RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR THE ANNUAL BUDGET JULY 1, 1946 TO JULY 1, 1947 FOR THE CITY OF WILLAMINA, OREGON

WHEREAS, It appears necessary and proper under the charter of the City of Willamina, Oregon, and the laws of the State of Oregon, and particularly under Chapter 393 of the 1943 Session Laws of the state of Oregon Amending Sections 100-1207 O.C.L.A. that the annual 1946-1947 budget for the city of Willamina be prepared and submitted to the legal voters and taxpayers of the said city, and providing for the city's fiscal needs; and

WHEREAS, It appears necessary that a budget committee be organized for the purpose of preparing and submitting said budget, and particularly as required by Chapter 393 of the 1943 Session laws of the State of Oregon Amending Section 100-1207 O.C.L.A., and it is the duty of the Common Council to appoint five qualified electors, citizens and freeholders of the City of Willamina, Oregon, to be members of the budget committee, and who shall not be officers, agents, or employees of the City of Willamina, Oregon, and which the members shall, with the members of the Common Council, constitute the members of the annual budget committee, and which budget committee shall convene and prepare all estimates required by law to be prepared and they shall serve without compensation.

THEREFORE, Be it Resolved by the Common Council at regular session that R. H. Yates, V. O. Huddleston, Julius Jensen, H. A. Parrett, and W. B. Matthews, who are citizens and taxpayers and otherwise qualified as by law required, be, and they are hereby appointed members of the 1946-1947 budget committee of the said City, and said committee is directed to convene on Monday, the 3rd day of June, 1946, at the hour of 8:00 P.M. of the said day, at the City Hall, and prepare and submit as estimates as required by said Act, together with members of the Common Council with the assistance of the Mayor, Recorder and City Treasurer, and who are thus to prepare said estimates of the financial needs of said city for submission of the same to the legal voters of the said City.

Be it further Resolved by the Common Council of the City of Willamina, Oregon, that upon the submission, completion and preparation of the estimates of the said budget requirements, the City Recorder is hereby directed to give notice of the time and place of hearing on the proposed budget as submitted by the budget committee, and all persons interested in the proposed tax levy may be heard for and against the said tax levy in the proposed budget, and notice thereof shall be given in the Willamina Times, a weekly newspaper published in said city for two issues immediately prior to the time set for hearing as by law required, as follows: One publication not less than twenty days before the date of said budget meeting as required by law, and which time for said hearing is hereby set by the Common Council for its regular monthly meeting on July 1, 1946 at the hour of 8:00 o'clock P.M. at the City Hall in Willamina, Oregon, and at that time the Common Council sitting as a levying board with the assistance of the Mayor, shall definitely determine the amounts required and necessary by the said city to meet all proper disbursements for the fiscal year from July 1, 1946 to July 1, 1947.

It is further ordered that the City Treasurer is hereby directed to furnish to the City Recorder as part of the publication of said proposed budget, a summary of estimates for the current year, and a summary of the expenditures for each of the two fiscal periods next preceeding the current year, and said two fiscal periods next preceeding the current years are July 1, 1944 to July 1, 1945, and

July 1, 1945, to July 1, 1946.
