Voted not to approve the recommendation of the Salem JOM Parent Committee that \$100 be donated to help pay a JOM student's travel cost to Washington, D.C. 5-4-0. 1/18/92.

Approved the Siletz Community Health Clinic Emergency Procedure Policy. 9-0-0. 1/18/92.

Accepted a bid from Charles Youngman to complete a project on Highway 229. 9-0-0. 1/18/92.

Elected Delores Pigsley as Tribal Council Chairman. 9-0-1. 2/2/92.

Elected Jessie Davis as Tribal Council Vice-Chairman by secret ballot. 6-3-0. 2/2/92.

Elected Mary Fisher as Tribal Council Secretary by secret ballot. 6-3-0.

Donated 3 Douglas Fir Utility Poles to the Nelechundun Business Council. 8-1-0. 2/2/92.

Approve a request for funds to perform a feasibility study on the Rock Creek Fish Hatchery. 8-0-0. 2/15/92.

Approved the creation of the following 11 new tribal employee positions: Comptroller, Property and Procurement Specialist, ADP Systems Analyst Officer,

Field Supervisor, Community Planner, Planning Clerk, Tribal Social Worker, Social Services Intake Worker, Tribal Work Experience Coordinator, Tribal Education Officer, Forestry Intern. 2/2/92. 9-0-0.

By the same resolution, Tribal Council increased the existing four part-time JOM Coordinator positions to full time and created an additional position called Library/Culture.

The same resolution divided the present newsletter/fish and game position into two separate full-time positions called Public Information Officer and Fish and Game Officer.

Approved, without resolution, culture projects in Springfield and Siletz on 2/16/92 and 4/10/92.

Approved, without resolution, delaying the deadline for Timber Revenue budget requests to June 1, 1992. 4/21/92.

Voted to increase the number of vendors at this year's Nesika Illahee Pow Wow and to charge for the Salmon Dinner. 7-0-0. 4/21/92.
