Social Security Q and A

QUESTION: How much can I own and still qualify for SSI payments? Will I have to sell my home?

ANSWER: In general, an individual can be eligible for SSI if he or she has assets with a value of \$1,500 or less. A home does not count as an asset, nor do

personal and household goods as a rule.

QUESTION: I plan to retire at the end of the year. I was going to take a day off from work to apply for my social security benefits, but my daughter told me I could apply by phone. Is this true?

ANSWER: Social security may not be able to complete your claim by phone, but they can start it for you. Almost all social security business — from applying for benefits to reporting a lost or stolen check — can be handled by telephone. This special telephone service is called Teleservice. To find your social security Teleservice number, look in your local telephone directory under Social Security.

QUESTION: I'm buying Medicare hospital insurance because I didn't work long enough under social security to be entitled to it. I also pay the monthly premium for the medical insurance part of Medicare. Paying both premiums takes a big bite out of my limited income. Can I drop the medical insurance?

ANSWER: People who buy Medicare hospital insurance must enroll and pay the premium for medical insurance, too. You cannot cancel the medical insurance part without losing your hospital insurance protection. But, you can cancel your hospital insurance and still continue your medical insurance.
