

SYEP BEGINS ENROLLMENT

Beginning May 1, youth between 14 and 21 who are CETA eligible, may enroll for the summer youth program in this area.

Youth 14 to 17 who do not yet possess a work permit are reminded to apply; and that the process may take up to three weeks to produce a permit. They must possess a work permit on the date of hire, June 15, in order to have a summer job.

At the same time the youth completes the CETA application (given by the school counselor) an appointment can be made to see Jane Martinez, SYEP Intake worker, for an interview. Intake interviews take about 30 minutes to complete. On this appointment the youth will be expected to submit verification (proof) of eligibility; a process which may take from a few days to a week.

There are a variety of jobs offered locally. Transportation to and from work is required. Work dates run from June 15 to August 30. Wages will be \$3.35 an hour for up to 32 hours per week. This work experience will provide young people with not only income, but also good supervision and an opportunity to be exposed to a variety of different types of jobs.
