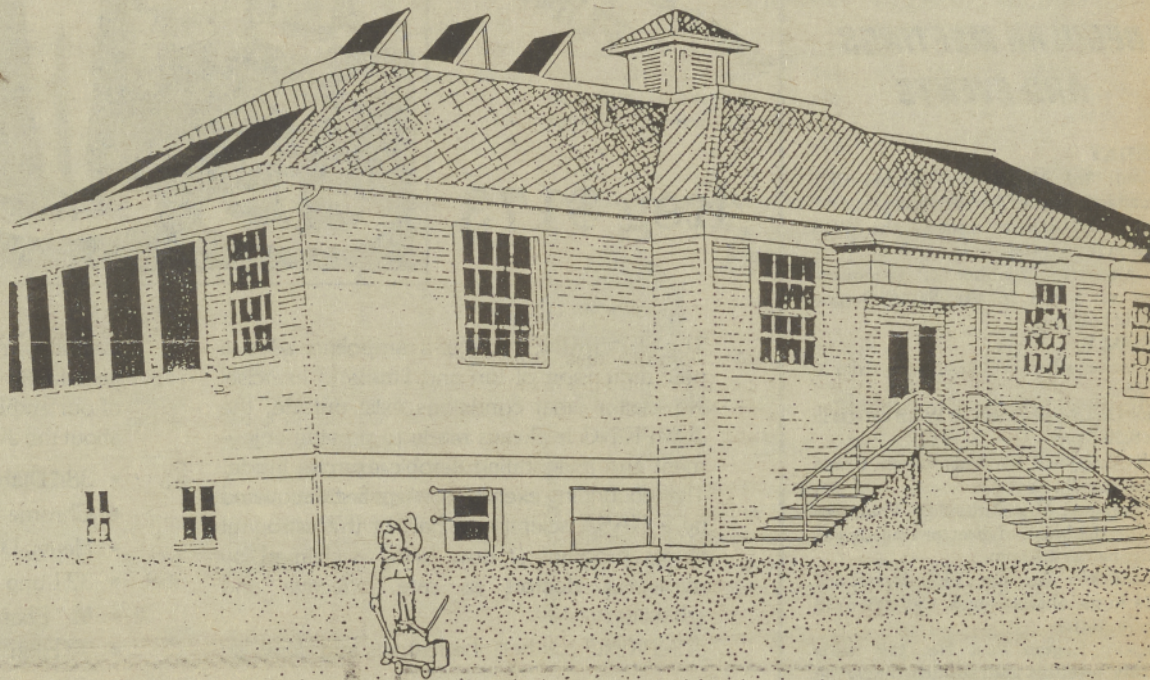

APPROPRIATE TECHNOLOGY EDUCATION AND RESEARCH CENTER



Community Action Team is directing an effort to renovate the Bachelor Flat School and convert it into a Community Energy Center.

Upon completion of the necessary renovation, the Center will be open to the public and will have:

- Solar Collectors for water and space heating
- Resource Library with technical manuals and self-help materials on appropriate energy technology
- Classroom Space for the Head Start pre-school program and for community education presentations
- Office Space for C.A.T.'s Home Weatherization program
- Workshop space, tools and equipment available to the public for production of home energy devices

The Center offers substantial benefits for all community residents. Through the Center's classes and workshops, homeowners can learn about and build home energy equipment, such as solar collectors, methane generators, small hydropower turbines. During renovation, training will be available for low income residents to become skilled solar technicians, valuable to the home building industry. Businesses can use the Center to discover energy-efficient methods, such as heat pumps and co-generation.

To provide these services, we must completely renovate the building. Walls must be insulated and recovered. Plumbing and wiring must be improved. Materials are needed for the solar heating collectors.

C.A.T. is requesting financial and material assistance from local groups and individuals to make this Center a reality. All donations are tax-deductible. We are available to make a slide presentation about this project before your civic organization, fraternal society, church group and business association.
