"I enjoy being a Jamboree Princess and find that it has been very exciting. I think the neatest thing I like is all the nice people I have met," Tawna says.

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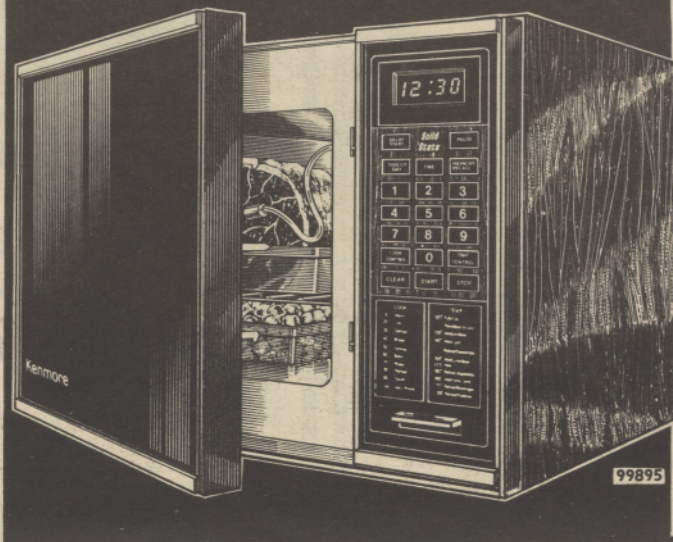
