

Cook-Out Recipes!!

Campfire Scones from Mrs. Grace Luibrand, Stevensville

2 cups sifted flour
1 Tbs. baking powder
1 Tbs. sugar
½ tsp. salt
¼ cup margarine
2 eggs
½ cup milk

Sift dry ingredients into bowl. Cut in margarine until mixture resembles coarse meal or crumbs. Make hollow in center. Beat eggs and add milk. Using a fork, stir into hollow in flour. Do not over-mix.

Knead lightly 5 times. Pull small pieces off dough and shape around end of peeled green sticks. Be sure to cover end of stick and spread dough thinly or it will not be baked in the center.

Hold over coals, rotating stick until golden brown. Remove from stick and fill with honey-butter or your desired filling.

For camping: dry ingredients and margarine can be prepared at home. Milk and eggs added at campsite.

Brazilian Barbecue from Mrs. Pam Johnson, Rudyard

4 lbs. ground chuck
½ cup water
½ cup vinegar
¼ cup cooking oil
1 tsp. celery seed
3 or 4 dashes hot pepper sauce
2 Tbs. instant coffee
1 tsp. salt
½ tsp. pepper
1 tsp. chili powder
1/8 tsp. garlic powder

Marinate overnight or all day. Cook on grill until done. Delicious with fresh corn on the cob and tossed salad.

Cherry-Glazed Ham Slice from Edna Boysun, Vida

Place smoked ham slices (¾ to 1 inch thick) on grill, not too close to coals. Brush with glaze. Broil on low, brush with glaze and turning ham 20-25 minutes.

Cherry Glaze: Combine 1 cup cherry preserves with 2 Tbs. lemon juice.

Marinate Steak Kabob from Agnes de Leon, Melrose

1 round steak, cut 1" thick, cut in 1-inch squares.

Marinate overnight in tangy Italian Dressing. Place on skewers:

1 square steak ... slice green pepper ... cherry tomato ... mushroom ... small onion ... and repeat.

Cook over barbecue five minutes.
