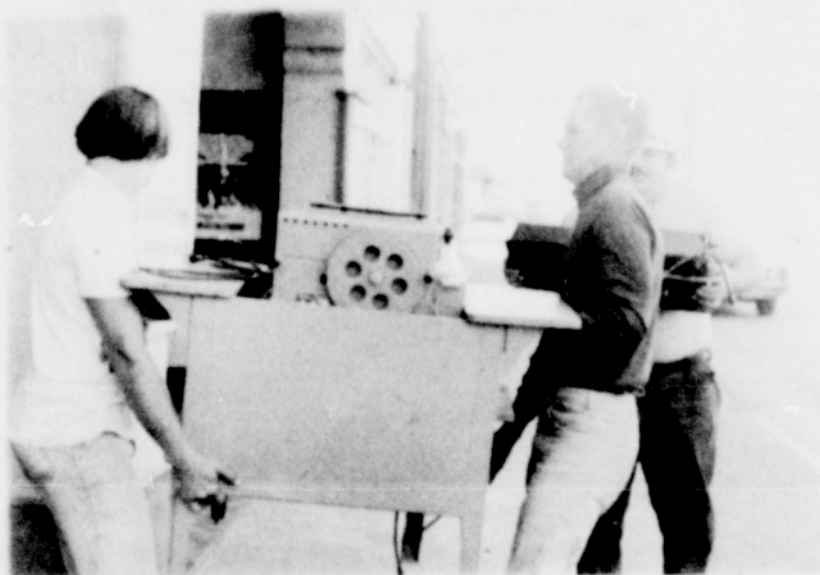

FIRE REPORT

December, 1977

The Vernonia Volunteer Fire Department answered 11 calls during the month of December including an electrical fire; four chimney fires; two high water standby; three rescue calls and one car fire.

Eight of the calls were within the city while three were in the rural area. The rescue calls were all for auto accidents.

The department showed 132.8 man hours on call with an average of 11.8 men per call.

The yearly report for 1977 showed the department answered 56 alarms during that time with 36 within the city and the other 20 within

Fire calls included 4 chimney fires; five electrical fires; four brush/grass fires; four wash downs; four house fires; three car fires; two barn fires; two trash fires; two high water standby; one camp trailer fire; one mutual aid to another department; one smoke investigation; one forest fire; one outbuilding fire; one business building

fire; one dryer fire; three overheated stoves; one fire out on arrival; one false alarm; and four rescue unit calls.
