Social Security

Question: My father is severely disabled and thinks he might be eligible for SSI payments. I've heard it takes time for an SSI claim to be processed. Is there any way he can get some financial help while he's waiting for his claim to go through? He has no income of his own.

Answer: A claimant who is otherwise eligible and is found presumptively disabled (or blind) can get SSI payments for up to three months while it is being decided if he or she is disabled or blind. When your father applies for SSI, the people in the social security office will tell him if he can get these payments.

Question: I am thinking about retiring from my barber shop, and plan to rent it to another barber. My total income may be about the same. Will this affect my social security checks?

Answer: Generally, income from rentals and other income not derived from work after you receive social security checks is not counted.

Question: What proofs will I need when I apply for social security retirement benefits?

Answer: Take your birth certificate and the birth certificates for any dependents you are also applying for, and
