NOTICE OF NONPROFIT DISSOLUTION-The nonprofit corporation is the Tribal membership and council elected prior to the Feb. 18, 1978 election of the Interim Council. One of the purposes of the March 3, 1979 General Council Meeting will be to consider whether the nonprofit corporation known as the Confederated Tribes of Siletz, Inc. should be "dissolved." This means that it would no longer be in existence. The Board of Directors has recommended that it be dissolved, its bills be paid and any money or property left over be given to the Paul Washington Cemetery Association. (It is unlikely that there will be any money left over, but state law requires that anything left be given to another non-profit, tax-exempt association.) The reason the Board has made the recommendation that the corporation be dissolved is because the Tribe is now a federally recognized Indian tribe and the nonprofit corporation is no longer necessary. This step cannot be taken without a vote of the general membership, so you will be asked to vote on it at the March meeting.
