At the June 19th meeting arrangements were made to host the nations meeting. Molly Woods of Chemawa was present. She was encouraging the help of the OLEA (Oregon Indian Education Association) to assist with the Career Workshop for Indian High School students. The tentative date is December 1981.

The past year the association helped with the state textbook review on history books. President LaVonne Edmo says that it is important that everyone write their Congressmen to encourage their support to continue Title IV and the JOM Programs for the 1982 year.
