We have submitted the Fy 82 budget. There has been a few major changes that everyone should know about.

Since President Reagan has been cutting our funds the Johnson O'Malley will be the first to get the axe. The money that our JOM Program will have to operate on for the next coming year is approximately \$17,000. With this amount of money the parent committee has decided to run a 9 month program. We will be in service during the school year.
