Springfield Christmas Parade

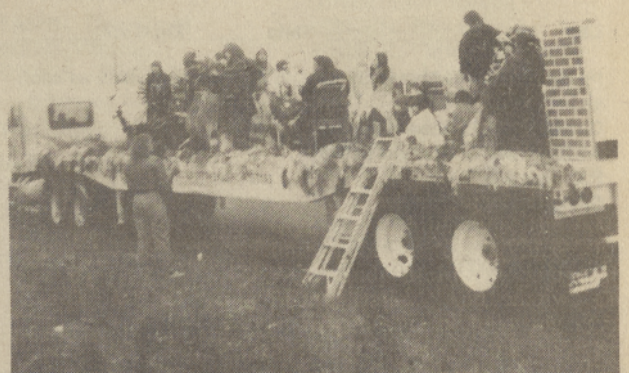
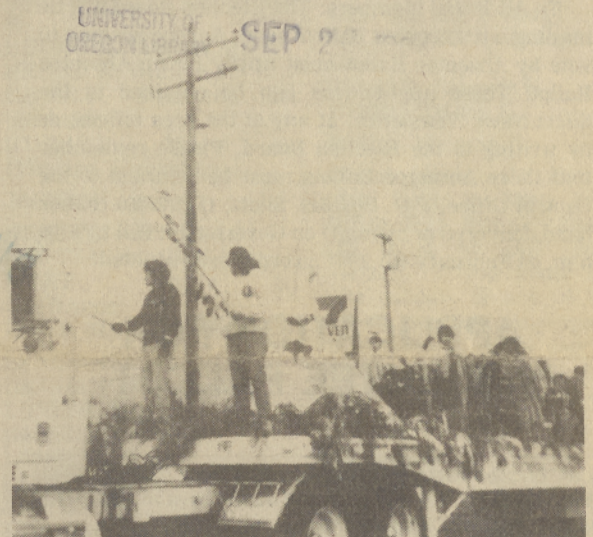
