Job Announcement Temporary Positions Open For Tree Planters

Applications are now being accepted by the Confederated Tribes of Siletz Indians for tree planters to work in reforesting the Sugus Hill Logging Unit. These are temporary positions. The work will start on February 21 and last until approximately March 2, 1984.

Applicants Must:

1. Be enrolled members of the Siletz Tribe,
2. Be at least 18 years old.
3. Be in good physical condition, be able to ascend and descend steep slopes, be willing to work in inclement weather and be willing and able to perform strenuous physical labor. Applicants may be required to supply proof of their physical condition.

Priority will be given to applicants who have previous tree planting experience.

Transportation from Siletz to the planting site and back, hard hats, planting tools and tree bags will be provided by the Siletz Tribe. Employees will be required to provide their own rain gear, boots and gloves. Compensation will be \$5.49/hour.

Applications are available at the Central Tribal Office and the Salem, Siletz and Springfield Area Offices. Applications will be turned in at, or mailed to the Central Tribal Office (Government Hill, Siletz). To be considered, applications must be received by the close of business (5:00 P.M.) on February 3, 1984.

The trees that will be planted are part of an important tribal cultural and economic resource, so it is imperative that tribal tree planters be willing to work their hardest to achieve a successful planting.

Job Opportunity Court Clerk

The Court Clerk will be responsible for all administrative functions of the tribal court. The position requires above average secretarial skills, a thorough working knowledge of tribal laws, customs and court procedures and the ability to communicate effectively both orally and in writing.

The clerk must be able to advise parties of the proper procedures for filing actions and, in some cases, assist in the preparation of court documents. The clerk will be responsible for scheduling and providing notice of court proceedings and maintaining accurate records of all court hearings and an organized filing system.

Position will be part-time, call-when-needed. Salary: \$5.00 per hour.
