Position Title: Forest Worker

Salary: \$5.36 - \$6.36 per hour, 40 hours per week

Minimum Requirements:

Applicants must: Be at least 18 years old; be in good physical condition, be able to ascend and descend steep slopes, be willing to work in heavy brush, inclement weather and smokey conditions and be willing and able to perform strenuous physical labor; and have experience in the safe operation of power saws to fell standing trees, to limb and buck downed trees and to slash brush.

Duties:

This employee will work as part of a 4-6 person crew doing reforestation, site preparation, prescribed burning, precommercial thinning, fire trailing, road clearing. Assignments will include: Planting bare root conifer seedlings with hoedads. Slashing of brush and hardwood trees using power saws. Building of fire trails using hand tools and power saws. Hand application of herbicide using back pack sprayers. Working on prescribed burns on hand ignition, holding and mop-up crews. Pre-commercial thinning of conifer and hardwood trees using power saws or hand tools and herbicides.

Minimum Requirements:

Applicants must: Be at least 18 years old; possess a valid Oregon driver's license; be in good physical condition, be able to ascend and descend steep slopes, be willing to work in heavy brush, inclement weather and smokey conditions and be willing and able to perform strenuous physical labor. Applicants must have: Experience in the safe operation, maintenance and sharpening of power saws; experience in construction of fire trails; experience in planting bare root conifer seedlings with hoedads; prescribed burning experience, experience in the safe hand application of herbicides; and demonstrated ability to supervise and work well with others.

Duties:

Supervise and work as part of a crew of forest workers doing reforestation, site preparation, prescribed burning, precommercial thinning, fire trailing, road clearing and hand application of herbicides. Maintain vehicle and equipment to assure safe and effective operation. Operate vehicle to transport crew and equipment. Assists Tribal Forester in operational planning of Forest Development and reforestation projects, in training crew members, in giving safety talks to crew members and in keeping time and attendance records for crew members. Ensure that crew is working in a safe manner and that all crew members understand the potential hazards inherent in the work.
