Siletz News Receives Award

The SILETZ NEWS was awarded a certificate for Overall General Excellence, at the First Annual Native American Press Conference, held in Warm Springs March 13-16, 1985.

The conference was attended by over 75 representatives of 35 Indian newspapers from across the U.S. and Canada.

Workshops were conducted in the areas of layout/design, writing/editing, business operation, and advertising.

Previous to the Conference Indian newspapers were encouraged to submit copies of their paper for competition. Apparently many did as over 100 entries were received, many by those who were unable to attend the conference.

Awards were given during the conference banquet on Friday March 15th. Awards were given in the areas of Creative Advertisement, News or Photo Series, Hard News Story, Feature Writing, Layout/Design, Editorial Writing, Column Writing, General Photo, and Overall General Excellence.

The SILETZ NEWS was one of five newspapers to receive an award for Overall General Excellence. Ammsa, a newspaper from Canada received a first place award. The Siletz News, along with the Seminole Tribune, How Ni Kan, and the Spilyay Tymoo received Honorable Mention.

Judging for the category of Overall General Excellence was based on the news writing, layout/design work, and the photography contained in the publication.

Judges for the competition were Tim Giago (Publisher of the Lakota Times), Loren Tapah (Publisher of the Navajo Times Today), Mike Burgess (Editor of Talking Leaf), and Bill Dulaney (Professor of Journalism at Penn State University).
