

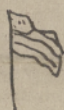

Adult Education

The Adult Education Program still has funds for Fiscal Year 1985. This program is for adult tribal members not currently enrolled in formal education courses and of 1/4 or more degree of Indian blood. You don't need to reside in the 8 county service area.

This program is designed to aid tribal members to:

- become functionally literate
- raise their levels of educational achievement through GED and other study courses
- improve employment status through education and training courses
- pursue special interests and training

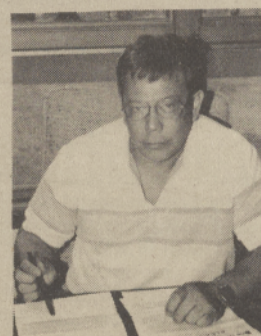

Rilatos New General Manager



Phil Rilatos

Tribal member Phil Rilatos, age 50, has been hired by the Tribal Council as the new General Manager for the Tribe. He replaces Bob Lockyear whose employment was terminated by the Council during the March 16th regular council meeting.

Phil has worked for the Tribe since June of 1984. He came to the Tribe as Comptroller.

One of his first objectives is to reorganize the administrative section. Phil believes that this will accomplish two things. One, it will diversify the scope of work so that each administrator is trained in all areas of administration. This is designed to create a team approach and will help the General Manager to reach the Tribal objectives created in the Comprehensive Plan.

Phil came to the Tribe after working for the Job Corp Center in Waldport where he still lives. He also spent 26 years in the Navy and left with the rank of Master Chief. He has a Bachelor's Degree in Behavioral Science and an Associate Degree in Accounting.
