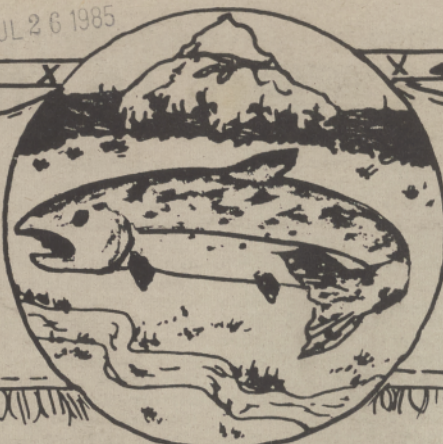

The first 2,000 lbs. of subsistence salmon were received on June 26, 1985 at the Dexter Holding Ponds near Springfield.

The fish were received 3 weeks before expected.

Special thanks to the 24 people who helped with the harvest. Due to their efficient work the salmon were kept in prime condition on a hot day.

The tribe will still receive another 2,000 lbs. this year from the state.

SILETZ COMMERCIAL MALL PROJECT

Siletz Tribal Administration is exploring the feasibility of the Tribe building a small commercial shopping mall in Siletz. Through a grant from the Administration for Native Americans, a marketing study is being conducted by the Portland firm, Leland and Hobson, Inc. This study will analyze the project's likelihood for success as an economic enterprise.

In addition to exploring whether the project would be a money-making venture, Tribal Administration needs to know if the project might also be successful in that it would provide a retail facility for tribal members interested in starting their own business in Siletz.
