HUNTING SEASON OPENS

DEER SEASON

Western Oregon Buck Season begins September 28, 1985. Tags are available for tribal members only. You must first have a tribal I.D. card to receive a tag.

These deer tags are available for distribution beginning September 16, 1985. They can be picked up from Brenda Bremner at the Siletz Area office. For your convenience, please call for an appointment between the hour of 8:00 a.m.-12:00 noon, Monday through Friday.

For tribal members living in the Salem, Springfield and Siletz areas who are unable to pick up tags in Siletz during regular work hours, there will be a special distribution of tags at the times stated below:

At local Area Office

IN SALEM: Tags will be distributed on Monday, September 23, 1985 from 4:00-7:00 p.m.

IN SPRINGFIELD: Tags will be distributed on Tuesday, September 24, 1985 from 4:00-7:00 p.m.

IN SILETZ: Tags will be distributed on Friday, September 27, 1985 from 4:00-7:00 p.m.

ELK SEASON

The tribe has been allowed a limited number of elk tags for the 1985 Roosevelt Elk hunting season. There are two seasons this year: the first season runs November 9 through November 12; and the second season runs November 16 through November 22.

Because of the limited number of tags, the Hunting and Fishing Committee is asking that all tribal members interested in obtaining an elk tag fill out the application below, and return it to C.T.S.I., ELK TAGS, P.O. Box 549, Siletz, OR 97380. Your application will be included in a drawing in mid-October to see which tribal members will receive tags. Names drawn will be notified by mail.
