In an effort to save money, the Tribe has changed its phone system slightly. There is now a toll free number for anyone within the State of Oregon, so collect calls are no longer necessary. Also, the Tribe has eliminated some telephone numbers which were not necessary. These include 444-2536, 444-2537, 444-2538, and 444-2528.

ENROLLMENT

Please contact the Enrollment Dept. at: Siletz Area office, P.O. Box 549, Siletz, OR 97380 or call: (Within Oregon 1-800-922-1399, outside Oregon 503) 444-2532 ext. 25, if you know the whereabouts of any of the above persons. Any questions on I.D. cards can be answered through the Enrollment Dept. or certifications of enrollment. The I.D. Machine is now located at the Enrollment Dept. in Siletz. Please call if you are coming in to make sure there will be someone here to help you.

Records. The staff shall maintain appropriate records to support its recommendations and maintain the roll as accurately as possible. The records shall include originals or copies of documents received to support applications. This part of the Enrollment Ordinance refers to name changes, birth-date changes and death removals. Certification of enrollment is requested from the Enrollment Dept. for almost all programs in the Tribe. If you have recently married or divorced and changed your name you need to contact the Enrollment Dept. to have your name changed on the Tribal roll. All certifications come directly from the information on the roll. Therefore, if the Enrollment Dept. cannot find you under your new name you will not be certified as an enrolled member.

Relinquishment. Any member of the Siletz Tribe may relinquish his or her membership in the Tribe by a written notice to the Tribal Council. Upon receipt of any such relinquishment, the Tribal Council shall enact a resolution directing the enrollment staff to remove the name of individual from the roll. The individual may re-apply for membership thereafter but must comply with the requirements of this ordinance.

Once you relinquish you forfeit all rights and privileges with the Tribe. You are removed from the roll. Your children are not eligible for enrollment then because they are not descendants of an enrolled member. (This does not apply to unborn babies). Once children turn 18 they have the right to make their own minds up to which Tribe they want to be affiliated with. This is a very serious step to take. Please contact the Enrollment Manager if you have any questions about this.
