Entertainer Willie Nelson visited for three hours recent at the Phoenix Indian School, an off-reservation boarding school in Phoenix, Arizona. During his visit Nelson briefly addressed a convocation and sang, "Welcome to the Promised Land." The Apache Ghost Dancers of the schools Apache Club and the Wisdom Dancers, a Phoenix-based dance group that has appeared with the singer on his concert tours, also performed at the convocation. After the convocation, Nelson spent an hour talking with the Indian students individually and autographing pictures. The entertainer's visit was arranged by Dennis Alley, a social worker at the school and a friend of Nelson's.
