BALLOT MEASURE

Compensation of Tribal Council Members

Explanation

This ballot measure proposes to increase the hourly payment for performance of Tribal Council duties by Tribal Council members from \$5.00 per hour to \$7.31 per hour. Tribal and Federal employees have received cost-of-living allowances (COLA) increases in their wages of 39.46% since 1978, during this same time Tribal Council hourly payments remained the same, tribal growth has tripled since 1978 and Tribal Council duties and responsibilities have increased accordingly. The increase represents a cost-of-living allowance (COLA) increase equal to that received by Federal and Tribal employees during the same time period.

"Subject to the availability of funds, Tribal Council members shall receive payment of \$7.31 per hour for time spent working on Tribal Council duties beginning November 1989. Tribal Council duties include attendance at tribal meetings, serving as tribal delegates to state, regional and national Indian organizations, and other work specifically authorized by vote of the Tribal Council. Tribal Council will be paid for their travel time, when in travel status for tribal business, not to exceed 8 hours per day.

"Accurate and complete records shall be kept and made available to the General Council on a regular basis."

APPLICATION FOR ABSENTEE BALLOT

Tribal members wishing to vote absentee must apply for an absentee ballot. Applicants must sign the request for absentee ballot and return it to the Election Board (this signature will be compared with the signature on the outer envelope when returned.) Tribal voters' printed name and signature must be the same as on the official tribal rolls. Requests for absentee ballots must be received by the Election Board no later than Friday, February 3, 1990. Absentee ballots must be returned to the Election Board no later than Saturday, February 3, 1990.
